Democracy is a form of government where citizens choose and replace the government through free and fair elections. Democracy allows active participation of the citizens in politics and civic life, protects the human rights of its citizens and applies laws and procedures equally to all citizens. In a democracy, eligible citizens are able to vote for the passing or rejecting of laws, run for office during elections, join political parties, sit on boards or committees, criticize or protest against the government, and receive a fair trial if accused of breaking the country's laws. Several variants of democracy exist, but there are two basic forms, both of which concern how the whole body of all eligible

citizens executes its will. One form of democracy is direct democracy, in which all eligible citizens have direct and active participation in the political decision-making. In most modern democracies, the whole body of eligible citizens remain the sovereign power but political power is exercised indirectly through elected representatives; this is called a representative democracy or democratic republic.
