They feed rats on simplified diets and find that their growth slows down or they develop some symptoms such as sore skins and sterility. Then something is added to the diet, and the rats resume normal growth or the symptoms clear up. The rat's needs are a fairly good guide to human ones, though not a complete one. For example, men but not rats, get scurvy if their diet lacks ascorbic acid (Vitamin C). Rets lose weight if deprived of a protein constituent called histidine and men do not. Nevertheless, our present very successful rationing system is largely based on experiment on rats.
