At such a time though very few people had expected it, the Congress party elected Lal Bahadur Shastri to take Nehru's place as the Prime Minister of India. And he did the best he could to light the way for his people at the time of great troubles. No man could have done more. Shastriji was only five feet two inches tall and his weight was about fifty kilograms. People in foreign countries used to call him 'The little sparrow'.
